CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

Welcome to the Wakatipu Dog Agility Club. The club was established to provide an opportunity for dogs and handlers to come together and participate in the fun sport of dog agility in a safe and supportive environment. As a club we appreciate active participation from all members, especially at times of fundraising or decision making.

There are some basic rules established by the WDAC, primarily for the purpose of dog and handler safety. Please read these rules carefully. Your signature on this form indicates you understand these rules, agree to abide by them and to actively promote them when participating in club training sessions.

- I. All dogs participating in foundation training sessions must be a minimum of 12 months. Dogs must be a minimum of 18months before training on elevated contact equipment or jumps other than those at micro height.
- II. All dogs must be considered in reasonable health and fitness. Dogs that are carrying excess weight will be advised to refrain from any jump/contact equipment until the instructor/s are satisfied they are in sufficiently healthy condition.
- III. All dogs participating in training involving equipment must either have the collar removed or be wearing a flat collar with no attachments other than a D-ring. Chain-style collars are not permitted. No dogs are permitted to negotiate equipment with a leash.
- IV. When not under direct instruction, dogs must be kept on a leash, crated or restrained in a (cool) vehicle at all times (other than toileting). At the discretion of the instructor/s the dogs may have a 'leash-free' run at the end of the class for socialisation purposes.
- V. It is recommended that handlers wear closed toe footwear with a reasonable amount of grip.
- VI. It is recommended that handlers who are aware that their dog has a large 'personal space' tie a Blue Ribbon to the leash/collar of their dog. The Blue Ribbon indicates to other handlers the dog does not react well should another encroach on their space. All handlers must respect this need and not allow their dog to become too close to the Blue Ribbon dog.
- VII. The direction of instructor/s should be followed during all training sessions, particularly with regard to matters of dog/handler safety.
- VIII. The handler agrees to keep their dog off the equipment before/after the session, unless under the supervision of instructor/s.
 - IX. Prospective members are encouraged to attend 3 training sessions free of charge. After this time a decision should be made as to the preferred type of membership and the appropriate membership fee paid promptly.
 - X. Handlers must toilet their dog prior to each class and as required during the class. Please bring plastic bags to clean up after your dog. Handlers must not permit their dogs to toilet in the area where equipment is set up or where other dogs are waiting. If a dog toilets on any equipment the handler may be asked to clean/disinfect that equipment.
- XI. Participation in any club training sessions or competition days is wholly at the risk of the handler and no responsibility will be taken for injury to dog or handler by Wakatipu Dog Agility Club or any of its members.
- XII. Any member who is concerned with the conduct of any other member/dog should discuss the matter with the instructor/s or a committee member. If they are not satisfied with the outcome, the concern should be addressed to the committee, in writing, for discussion at the next scheduled committee meeting.
